Background Information

The Global Migration Data Analysis Centre (GMDAC) is part of the International Organization for Migration (IOM) and responsible for providing all stakeholders with a better understanding of global migration data. GMDAC is involved in a variety of tasks including research, capacity building and knowledge management (communication).

GMDAC acquired the Gallup World Poll data to leverage global survey data to inform migration policy and research. For this project, we seek a candidate with strong technical skills in data management, cleaning and analysis; experience working with large-scale survey data; and (ideally) fluency with multiple software platforms (particularly Stata). GMDAC aims to exploit the Gallup World Poll for analysis of emigration intentions, public opinion on immigration, remittances, and diversity acceptance.

General Functions

In accordance with the overall direction of the Director of the Department of International Cooperation and Partnerships and in coordination with the Director of the GMDAC and the GMDAC team, the incumbent will perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- Support the production of several regular dissemination products (briefs, presentations, and reports) using the Gallup World Poll;
- Contribute to the development of several products focusing on a specific topic agreed with the research team;
- Compile, prepare, clean and manage data;
- Contribute to GMDAC publications regarding Gallup World Poll data;
- Contribute to report writing, visualizations and presentations on the work produced in the context of this program.
